Mercury Marine Group

Based in Fond du Lac, Wisconsin, Mercury Marine is the leading producer of marine engines in the world. 2006 net sales were \$2.3 billion. Primary products include *Mercury* and *Mariner* outboard engines; *Mercury MerCruiser* sterndrive and inboard engines; *Mercury Precision Parts* and accessories; and *MotoTron* electronic controls.

Brunswick Boat Group

Headquartered in Knoxville, Tennessee, the Brunswick Boat Group is the largest maker of pleasure boats in the world. 2006 net sales were \$2.8 billion. The Boat Group makes *Sea Ray*, *Bayliner*, *Maxum*, *Hatteras*, *Meridian* and *Sealine* pleasure boats from 16 to 100 feet; *Baja* high-performance boats from 20 to 44 feet; *Albemarle*, *Boston Whaler*, *Cabo Yachts*, *Laguna*, *Palmetto*, *Sea Boss*, *Sea Pro* and *Trophy* offshore fishing boats from 13 to 52 feet; and *Crestliner*, *HarrisKayot*, *Lowe*, *Lund*, *Princecraft* and *Triton* fishing, deck and pontoon boats from 10 to 26 feet; *Attwood*, marine parts and accessories; *Kellogg Marine*, *Land 'N' Sea*, *Benrock* and *Diversified Marine* parts and accessories distributors; and *IDS* dealer management systems. Brunswick is one of the largest boat makers by units in Europe, with such brands as *Arvor*, *Örnvik*, *Quicksilver*, *Uttern* and *Valiant* boats.

Life Fitness Division

The Life Fitness Division is the global leader in high-quality commercial and consumer cardiovascular and strength training equipment. 2006 net sales were \$593 million. Based in Schiller Park, Illinois, it markets and manufactures *Life Fitness*, *Hammer Strength* and *ParaBody* equipment serving health clubs, professional athletic teams, university athletic departments and the military.

Brunswick Bowling & Billiards

Brunswick Bowling & Billiards is based in Lake Forest, Illinois. Net sales in 2006 were \$458 million. Brunswick makes bowling equipment and supplies as well as operates 108 family bowling centers throughout the United States, Canada and Europe. Brunswick billiards tables and accessories are the market leaders and recognized around the world for their superior construction, style and performance. Brunswick also makes *Valley-Dynamo* pool, *Air Hockey* and *foosball* tables.

Brunswick New Technologies

On April 27, 2006, Brunswick announced that it was pursuing a sale of these units.

Brunswick New Technologies, headquartered in Lake Forest, Ill., is now comprised of a fleet management system. Brunswick has completed the sale of the marine electronics and personal navigation device businesses in separate transactions with Navico and MiTac, respectively.

BNT had included *Navman NZ Limited*, a New Zealand-based leader in global positioning system (GPS)-based products and marine electronics; *Northstar Technologies*, marine navigational systems; and *MX Marine*, a maker of high-end marine GPS products and automatic identification systems transponders.
